The Department of Religion provides a Christ-centered and Bible-based religious education that is in line with the global mission and message of the Seventh-day Adventist Church. Emphasis is placed on such areas as biblical understanding, personal application, and service to the church. Classes in this major are typically small, which provides ample time for interaction between professor and student. The program also offers the opportunity to add other areas (minors) that best fit the academic and professional goals of the student.

Job Market

Our students often double-major in a related field and they can pursue graduate work and employment in various fields of studies. Many of our graduates are accepted into the Seminary or enter other graduate programs for chaplaincy, Bible workers, counseling, or teaching. Some are hired as Bible teachers in various Adventist educational institutions or dorm deans in Adventist academies. They also become qualified to work as missionaries, colporteur directors, religion editors in publishing companies.

Job Outlook

Job opportunities increase as graduates combine their degree with other areas of emphasis like education, business, psychology, etc. In the next few years, these opportunities will augment as a growing number of Adventist educators and other workers in North America will retire from active service.

Earnings

Although earnings will vary widely by region and position, an average salary for a pastor is about \$55,000. The beginning salary for a new pastor just starting out may be somewhat less.

Educational Qualifications

Graduates are strongly encouraged to pursue graduate work in order to meet the demands of a highly educated society and the needs of local institutions. A doctorate will be required for those who want to teach religion at an Adventist college or Seminary level.
