The student will develop competencies in integrity, research, and critical thinking, communications, leadership, & professional skills through classroom instruction and activities, projects, case studies, interaction with professionals from the community, and other methods.

Job Market

Operations Management majors will find jobs with companies such as Amazon, Lockheed Martin, FedEx, Dell, and Apple in fields such as Manufacturing, Airlines, Wholesaling and Distributing, Freight, Third-Party Logistics, and Consumer Goods to name a few. Some of our graduates choose to continue their education in graduate school resulting in successful careers in many of these fields at an even higher level.

Job Outlook

According to the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics, between the years 2021 and 2031 there will be an increase of about 24,200 (24%) jobs in Operations Research Analytics. Logisticians will find about 54,100 new jobs between 2021-2031(28% increase).

Earnings

Earnings potential for graduates with Operations Management degrees varies widely depending on many factors including the geographic location, the industry you choose, position, skills, and experience. According to the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics (2021), the median annual income of an Operations Research Analyst is \$82,360 while Logisticians earn a median salary of \$77,030.

A bachelor's degree qualifies an individual for most entry-level positions. However, a graduate degree will significantly increase the potential of obtaining many positions as well as earning potential.
