The Bachelor of Science (BS) in Business is intended to be a general business degree. This degree gives students pursuing other areas of interest (i.e., pre-med, pre-dental, pre-law, etc.) more flexibility to invest in other fields while still developing the breadth of management, interpersonal and professional skill required in today's complex business world. The BS in Business degree is also designed to be compatible with Southwestern's Distance Education program.

Job Market

The job market for a general business degree is broad and our graduates find jobs such as human resources, compensation or benefits specialists, purchasing, administration executives, administration assistants, administrative support, data entry and analysis, healthcare administration and support, insurance or medical claims and billing, and many others. Some of our graduates choose to continue their education in graduate school resulting in successful careers in many of these fields at an even higher level.

Job Outlook

The job outlook for individuals with general business degrees continues to improve. According to the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics, overall employment in business and financial occupations is projected to grow 7% from 2021-2023; this increase is expected to result in about 715,000 jobs. Additionally, opportunities arise from the need to replace workers who leave their occupations permanently for about 980,200 opening each year, on average.

Earnings

Earnings potential for graduates with general business degrees varies widely depending on many factors including the geographic location, the industry you choose, position, skills, and experience. According to the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics (May 2021), the median annual wage for business and financial occupations is \$76,570.

A bachelor's degree qualifies an individual for most entry-level positions. However, a graduate degree will significantly increase the potential of obtaining many positions as well as earning potential.
