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### LOCATION

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Southwestern Adventist University's Education Department offers degrees in elementary and secondary education. Individuals prepare for certification in both Texas public schools and Seventh-day Adventist schools. Certification options range from early childhood through 12th grade. Individuals seeking secondary certification must complete a major or minor in a specified discipline while completing additional courses towards teacher certification. Secondary teaching credentials are available in history, life sciences, mathematics, music, and physical education. (See undergraduate bulletin for more info on secondary certification.)

We offer unique opportunities for students planning to become teachers. Field experience begins in the freshmen year. Students have opportunities to be involved in public and private schools. In addition, there are opportunities in the community to tutor in school-based programs, provide after school reading support, and participate in campus activities in local schools.

### Job Market

100% of our graduates seeking Texas State credentials pass the certification exams. All of our graduates seeking employment in a school are offered positions within one year of graduation. Future possibilities with experience and additional education include curriculum specialist, diagnostician, interventionist, school librarian, principal, school counselors, and other school leaders.

### Job Outlook

K-12 teaching jobs are expected to grow by 12 percent through 2022, according to the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics. Mathematics, science and bilingual education teachers are in particular demand, as are education majors who are licensed to teach in more than one subject area. Job prospects also tend to be higher in urban and rural school districts.

### Earnings

Depending on the area of the country, you can expect a salary range of \$35,000- \$55,000 as a first-year teacher
