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Southwestern Adventist University's Education and Psychology Department offers a Bachelor of Science in Psychology with Emphasis in School Guidance. The degree combines courses in education and psychology to prepare individuals for careers in school counseling and teaching. School counselors in the state of Texas need two years of teaching experience and a master's degree in school counseling prior to licensure and employment as a school counselor.

We offer unique opportunities for students to have field experience in public and private school settings. Field experience is integrated into the program from the freshman year. Field experience in psychology is also included.

Job Market

University alumni surveys find that psychology with emphasis in school guidance graduates are currently working as bilingual teachers, school counselors and teachers.

Job Outlook

A number of institutions hire graduates with a bachelor's degree, thus the outlook for a psychology major is excellent. Training in critical thinking, interpersonal communications, and human behavior makes graduates in this field highly versatile and employable. Preparation for teacher certification increases job options for those with this degree.

Earnings

Depending on the area of the country and type of job, grads can expect to earn a salary range of \$30,000-\$52,000.

Educational Qualifications

Students must pass Texas certification exams for teaching. Advancement to a school counseling position requires two years of teaching experience and a master's degree. Students planning to teach at tertiary level in psychology programs must have at least one area of expertise and a doctorate degree is preferred.
