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A Social Science degree from Southwestern is the lesser-known brother of the History degree. With concentrations in political science, economics, and geography, as well as history, graduates with Social Science degrees can do everything those with History degrees can do—and more. Those multiple concentrations make Social Science degree holders especially attractive to small schools. Plus, a Social Science degree is the preferred degree for students wanting to go on to law school.

Job Market

Teaching is the obvious job people associate with a Social Science degree, but the opportunities are much broader than that. Social Science serves as a great background for jobs in journalism, libraries, public service, public policy, politics, or private business. You may want to pair a History degree with another discipline to open even more doors.

Job Outlook

The U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics expects employment for people with Social Science degrees to increase 3% through 2026. The job is particularly good for people who have the research and writing skills of a Social Science degree with graduate education in other fields, such as library science, political science, law, or history.

Earnings

Earnings will vary by job and region. However, here are some yearly earnings averages for a variety of careers include: high school history teacher, \$59,170; lawyer, \$119,000; political scientist (with MA), \$115,110; college professor, \$76,000.

A Social Science degree will help many graduates get entry-level jobs. However, pairing the degree with a graduate degree will usually bring higher rewards. Some careers, such as being a lawyer or teaching in college, mandate graduate degrees.
